

2010 Cookie Activity Permission Slip

Complete one per Girl Scout and return to Troop/Group Leader or ZIP Mentor

I understand that I should attend cookie training provided by my daughter's troop and that I must provide adult supervision of my daughter's participation in the activity at all times.

- ◆ I understand that cookie orders **may not be taken, in any form, before January 8, 2010**. As a Girl Scout, your daughter has promised to be honest and fair. Any orders taken prior to this time will be deducted from her total sales when determining her incentives. If we are unable to determine specific orders, 10% of her sales will be deducted.
- ◆ Girls or their families may not engage in selling Girl Scout Cookies on the Internet. Girls can use e-mail as a marketing tool to let family, friends, and former customers know about the sale. Girls or their parents should not broadcast emails to parental membership lists or place of employment email lists. Girls or their parents can not set up online ordering or payment on private web pages. Lists of customers and their emails should be treated with respect and girls should be instructed on privacy issues.
- ◆ Individual girls or troops should not advertise in commercial or private publications.
- ◆ I understand that cookies cost **\$4.00** per package. I also understand that **money for cookies is not collected until the customer receives their package(s) of cookies**. The exception is for cookies donated to the Gift of Caring activity.
- ◆ I have reviewed the Incentives Brochure and understand that Cookie Dough's can be used for Cookie Dough items ordered ONLY through the troop at the end of the sale, to pay for Council events and camps, for membership registration and in the Council Shops. **Previous year cookie doughs may not be used for current earned cookie incentives. In the event a chosen item is not available, cookie doughs will be substituted.**
- ◆ Troops who have ordered cookie incentives on time should have them distributed to girls by late May. Please check with your troop leader if these have not been received. **June 4th is the last day to report award discrepancies to the Council Director of Product Sales.**
- ◆ I agree to accept responsibility for all cookies and money my Girl Scout receives and to assist her in making prompt payments for cookies entrusted to her. I understand that monies collected by my Girl Scout belong to the Girl Scouts of Gateway Council. In the event of non-payment for the cookies received, I understand that Girl Scouts of Gateway Council reserves the right to initiate collection procedures by its designated agent, including civil suit and criminal prosecution on accounts delinquent after 10 days from the due date, March 20, 2009. I further understand that all costs associated with the above mentioned collection process, including collection and/or attorney fees incurred, will be my responsibility. I understand that cookies received may NOT be returned.

The purposes of the cookie activity is to teach girls to work as a team, set goals and strive to achieve them, handle and account for money, and develop sales and marketing skills. The money earned supports troop activities and other program services and opportunities throughout Girl Scouts of Gateway Council.
