Let girls take the lead! Help them find the experiences that are just right for them.




Frozen Banana Cereal Pops

Ingredients

- 3/4 cup strawberry yogurt (non-dairy works too!)
- 2 cups Fruity Pebbles cereal (or any you have handy!)
- 4 medium bananas, peeled and cut crosswise in half
- 8 wooden pop sticks

Directions

- Place yogurt and cereal in separate shallow bowls. Insert pop sticks through cut side of bananas. Dip bananas in yogurt, then roll in cereal to coat. Transfer to waxed paper-lined baking sheets.
- Freeze until firm, about 1 hour. Transfer to airtight freezer containers; seal containers and return pops to freezer.
